RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hispanic National Bar Association is holding its 36th annual convention in Dallas on August 31 through September 3, 2011; and

WHEREAS, The association represents the interests of more than 100,000 Hispanic attorneys, judges, law professors, legal assistants, and law students in the United States and its territories; and
